- Collaborating with the ACHSC's Content Development Team to review and update current Masterclass learning plans
- Collaborating with HSCM co-directors to develop a new online platform to supplement Masterclasses delivery

- Tangible teaching and mentorship experience to promote cancer awareness at a grassroots level and enable passionate students to enact meaningful change in their communities
- An opportunity to contribute to the development of an innovative web-based education platform and cancer curriculum
- Opportunities to develop professional communication and teaching skills

- Sound knowledge of cancer biology, causes, types, treatment, prevention etc. at least to the level outlined in the ACHSC Cancer Syllabus (<https://achsc.gitbooks.io/syllabus/>; essential)
- Previous high school tutoring/mentoring experience (strongly preferred)
- Passion for teaching and improving cancer literacy and interest in providing mentorship about health sciences careers and study pathways
- Strong organisational and communication skills
- Experience or demonstrated ability to work closely with a team of like-minded individuals
- Capacity to travel to Melbourne metropolitan schools (if necessary; travel costs will be reimbursed)
